Screening and Surveillance Guidelines

Eligibility

The CRCP provides colorectal cancer screening services to program eligible men and women as recommended by the United States Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF). The priority populations for CRCP screening services are:

- men and women between the ages of 50 and 64 years
- low income up to 250% of the FPL
- Inadequate or no health insurance.

Income at or below 250% of the Federal Poverty Level: This is based on patient report and is to be determined using the following information:
